On Sunday February 11, 2007 Lt Domanski and the undersigned responded via county police vehicle to Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina. The purpose of the trip was to meet with Nerissa Wharton (v) regarding two photo arrays shown to her by Special Agent Daniel Snow with the Federal Bureau of Investigation on December 26, 2006. In the first photo array shown by Special Agent Snow Nerissa (v) identified Alex Cancinos (s) as the driver of the vehicle and as one of the two Hispanic males that sexually assaulted her in July of 2004. Special Agent Snow showed Nerissa (v) a second photo array and she was unable to identify anyone in that array. It should be noted that the second photo array contained Elmo Rivadeneira's (s) photograph. For further details refer to the Federal Bureau of Investigation report file #31BNK113496.

At approximately 7:30pm Lt Domanski and the undersigned met with Nerissa Wharton (v) in an interview room at the Kill Devil Hills Police Department. At that time Lt Domanski and the undersigned had the opportunity to secure a sworn audiotape statement of Nerissa Wharton (v). The following is a brief narrative of Nerissa Wharton's interview and sworn audiotape statement.

Nerissa Wharton (v) stated during the interview that on July 16, 2004 while working as a prostitute in Elizabeth, New Jersey two Hispanic males pulled up in a Maxima, she thought to proposition her. Nerissa stated that she got into the vehicle and instructed the two males to drive to a certain location but instead they forced her to put

her head down while in the back of the vehicle and drove to another location. Nerissa said that upon their arrival she was instructed out of the vehicle and onto the hood of the Maxima. Nerissa stated that the driver showed a police badge and identified himself as a police officer to her. She stated that once in the vehicle the driver instructed her not to scream or "he would hurt me." It should be noted that Nerissa (v) stated that the driver was in possession of a knife. Nerissa stated that both unknown Hispanic males sexually assaulted her by forcing their penis into her vagina against her will. It should be noted that Nerissa stated that no money exchanged hands between her and the two unknown Hispanic males. Nerissa said that when finished the two unknown Hispanic males took her Nextel cellular telephone and purse with various belongings and then instructed her to count to one hundred leaving her at the unknown location. Nerissa (v) stated that once released she ran to a warehouse and called her pimp, "Bird" who responded to the location to pick her up. At that time Lt Domanski and the undersigned showed Nerissa (v) a copy of the FBI photo array containing Alex Cancinos's (s) photograph and asked her to verify her signature taken by Special Agent Snow during the admission of the array. Nerissa immediately pointed at Alex Cancinos's photograph once again identifying him as one of her attackers and confirmed that she did in fact meet with Special Agent Snow verifying her signature upon selecting Alex's photo from the array in December.

For further details refer to the transcript of the sworn audiotape statement. It should be noted that the original sworn audiotape statement of Nerissa Wharton (v) and a copy of the FBI photo array has been secured into evidence at the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office as items #1 and #2, respectfully.

On Monday February 12, 2007 Lt Domanski and the undersigned returned to New Jersey from Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina.




NARRATIVE

On Thursday March 1, 2007 at 536 South 11th Street in Newark, NJ Lt George Domanski, Det O'Reilly and the undersigned along with members of the FBI Newark Field Office and the United States Marshals Office arrested without incident Mr. Alex Cancinos pursuant to Warrant #W826057 for Armed Robbery 2C:15-1 and Impersonating a Law Enforcement Officer 2C:28-8b; Warrant #W826069 for Kidnapping 2C:13-1b and Terroristic Threats 2C:12-3a; and Warrant #W826067 for Aggravated Sexual Assault 2C:14-2a(4) and Aggravated Sexual Assault 2C:14-2a(3). Mr. Cancinos was processed and transported to the HCSD for fingerprinting and photographing. Finally, Mr. Cancinos was taken to CJP Court for arraignment in this matter and turned over to the HCSD for transport to the Hudson County Correctional Facility.

N [REDACTED], who resides at [REDACTED], cellular phone number 2 [REDACTED] was interviewed at her residence, on December 26, 2006. SA Daniel D. Snow presented W [REDACTED] with two photographic arrays, which were provided to SA Snow by SA Shawn Manson, of the Newark Division.

Before presenting the photographs, SA Snow advised W [REDACTED] that a subject may or may not be present in the array. SA Snow then presented array number one to W [REDACTED] which is identified by the number "1" written on the back of the array. W [REDACTED] reviewed the array and she tentatively stated that the individual in position 1 "looked like" one of the subjects.

SA Snow then presented the second array, which is identified by the number "2" written on the back of the array. W [REDACTED] reviewed the array and quickly and definitely pointed to the individual in position 4. W [REDACTED] stated that she definitely recognized him as one of the subjects.

After selecting individuals in both arrays, W [REDACTED] signed her name on the back of the array over the individuals that she had selected.
